COVID VACCINE UPDATE FROM VILLAGE INTERNAL MEDICINE GROUP:

Dear Patient,

As you may already know, the FDA has approved Pfizer's and Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.

Village Internal Medicine Group does **NOT** currently have the vaccine, but we are doing all that is requested to receive our limited supply.

Once we receive the vaccine, **we will reach out to you** and provide directions to getting vaccinated.

Please continue reading for more detailed information.

WHAT WE ARE DOING RIGHT NOW

As stated above, since we believe our first shipment will be a limited supply, we are currently searching through our Electronic Health Record system to find those of you who are at the greatest risk. We are working with authorities to get the vaccine and are required to closely monitor stability with a certified instrument.

HOW WILL YOU NOTIFY ME? WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

We will reach out to you (email, text, and phone calls) to let you know it is your time to get vaccinated.

When you are contacted, you will be asked to complete and submit a questionnaire.

Based on the answers questionnaire, we will contact you to confirm your scheduled time and give further instructions.

I WANT THE VACCINE NOW!

It is possible that you may be able to find the vaccination through other sources, such as hospitals or pharmacies.
